Mennonite Central Commitee is requesting relief kits and hygiene kits for needs in the Middle East and other places around the world.

Relief Kit

Contents (NEW items, in original packaging)

- 4 large bars bath soap 1 plastic bottle shampoo (13-24 oz; place in resealable plastic bag)
- 4 large bars laundry soap (Some stores carry Fels Naptha®, Sunlight® or Zote[®] brands)
- 4 adult-size toothbrushes
- 4 new bath towels (medium weight, dark or bright colors)
- 2 wide-tooth combs (6-8 in)
- 1 fingernail clipper(good quality)
- 1 box adhesive bandages(minimum 40 count, assorted)
- 1 package sanitary pads (18-24 count thin maxi)

Thank you for limiting your generosity to the items listed. MCC no longer asks for toothpaste to be donated with the kits due to strict regulations on the expiration dates.

Place contents in a box or bag and deliver to Material Resource Center of Harleysville. The kit will be re-packed in a new 5-gallon plastic pail with lid.

Hygiene Kit

Contents (NEW items, in original packaging)

- 1 adult-size toothbrush
- 1 large bar bath soap
- 1 fingernail clipper (good quality)
- 1 hand towel (dark color)

Thank you for limiting your generosity to the items listed. MCC no longer asks for toothpaste to be donated with the kits due to strict regulations on the expiration dates.

Hygiene kits are distributed in a useful, double-drawstring cloth bag (11in x 16in). You may request bags from Material Resource Center of Harleysville or donate contents that we will place in a bag. Bring completed kits to Material Resource Center of Harleysville.



Did you know?

Our Comforter Blitz yielded 31 comforters for MCC and lots of good fellowship time. The need for comforters is ongoing; MCC has recently shipped comforters and blankets to countries such as Ethiopia, Jordan, Iraq, Palestine/Gaza, North Korea and Haiti.



Sale of baled excess items from Care and Share has helped to provide funds for our work of supporting Mennonite Central Committee with funds and material resources. The approximate value of items sent to MCC in 2013 is \$240,128; monetary donations of \$106,630 were also sent to MCC and several local non-profits.

As we celebrate 11 years of working to support MCC we thank God for all the help and support from many churches, individuals and businesses.
